Thank you for your email of **3 October 2024** requesting the following information:

I have just read via Waikanae Community Board

"He said the council had established its emergency management team in response to last year's emergency, with 70 staff members now part of that workforce."

Please Advise via OIA:

1) What are these 70 !!! Staff employed doing? As we are continually told that there is really now no civil defence and we need to know our community and rely on neighbours.

The 70 staff members are council employees who have volunteered to join the emergency management workforce alongside their regular roles. They operate our Emergency Operations Centre (EOC), working on the ground and coordinating with the Wellington Region Emergency Management Office (WREMO), as well as first responders and lifeline services, including Police, Fire and Emergency New Zealand, Electra, and others. Additionally, they collaborate with volunteer organizations such as the Red Cross, Animal Evac NZ, and HUHA.

2) What is the \$\$\$ amount in salaries for these 70 people?

No additional salaries as they are already employed by the Council.
