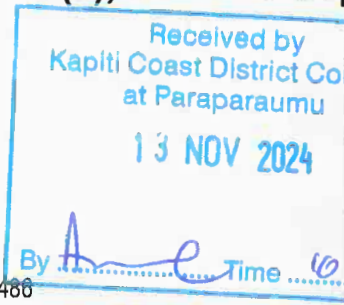

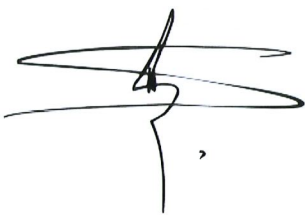

Conclusion

This application is for a new Club Licence with change of Licence name in order to accommodate the above existing premises.

The premises are an existing Bowling Club that is amalgamating with the Waikanae Bowling Club Incorporated which is currently located at 354-356 Te Moana Road, Waikanae.

The Applicant has filed a name change with the Incorporated Societies Register and is seeking to hold a Club Licence for both Club premises under the society's new name 'Waikanae United Bowling Club Incorporated'. Each Club will continue to operate under their current name. The Applicant will submit an application for a new Club licence for the premises known as 'Waikanae Beach Bowling Club'.

According to Council records the Applicant (Waikanae Beach Bowling Club Inc.) has held a licence for clubrooms at 18 Huiawa Street, Waikanae Beach since at least 1990 (earliest record on Council file).

The general nature of the business is that of a sporting club, the principal business being the participation in and promotion of sport (lawn bowls).

The clubrooms are predominantly utilised by members and their guests including occasional social functions (birthdays, anniversaries etc). Special licences have previously been granted to the Club when the facilities have been used by non-members, for example business Christmas functions.

The current owner of the premises (Waikanae Beach Bowling Club) has given permission in a letter to Council (dated 24.7.2023), for the Applicant (Waikanae United Bowling Club Inc) to sell alcohol from the premises.

As previously noted, the premises are located within land zoned Open Space (Precinct 35 - Open Space Private Recreation & Leisure Precinct) under the Operative Kapiti Coast District Plan 2021. The District Plan provisions that relate to the land apply.

Resource Consent application RM000239 (Subdivision: Boundary Adjustment - Waikanae Bowling Club) listed above, was granted by Council in 2000 in relation to the subject site.

The immediate and surrounding environment predominantly comprises land which is zoned Open Space and General Residential. Waikanae Golf Club is located approximately 300 metres to the Southeast in Te Moana Road, and a Local Centre Zone lies approximately 140 metres to the Southwest situated on the corner of Te Moana Road & Rangihiroa Street, Waikanae.

Resource Consent was not required for the land use as it is a permitted activity.

The Applicant is advised however, that should the scale and intensity of the existing activity increase, a resource consent application may be required.

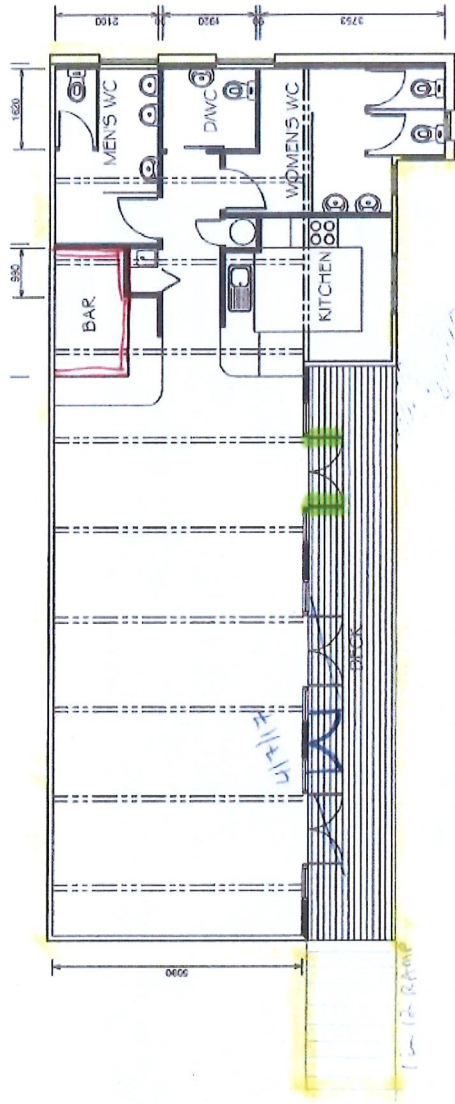

Floor Plan Alcohol Licenced Area

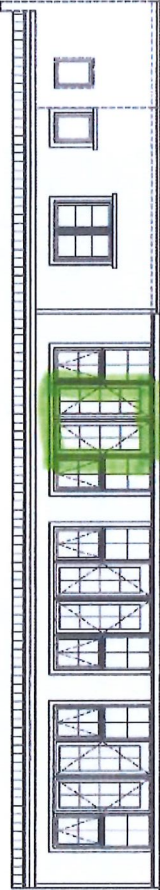
