Thank you for your email of **4 June 2024** requesting the following information:

I would like to request the following information:

1. How many resource consents were received between 19<sup>th</sup> Sept 2023 – 19 Feb 2024 and how of how many of them consents was an official Further Request for Information issued?

During this period, Council received 100 resource consents of which 62 required further information.

2. How many resource consents have been received over the last 12 months and how of how many of them consents was an official Further Request for Information issued?

During this period, Council received 261 resource consents of which 162 required further information.

3. How many resource consents have been received over the last 6 months and how of how many of them consents was an official Further Request for Information issued?

During this period, 110 resource consents were received and 75 required further information.

4. How many resource consents have been received over the last 3 months and how of how many of them consents was an official Further Request for Information issued?

During this period, 55 resource consents were received and 42 required further information.

The average for this period was processing day 12.

6. How many applications have been subject to Section37 extensions in the last 6 months (as a percentage)
