Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your email of **11 September 2024** requesting the following information:

- 1. Total market for over-road structures (also known as gantry, cantilever and monopoles) and the corresponding signage
 - a) Structure that holds the sign:
 - Location of structure
 - Material the structure is made out of
 - Style of structure build (i.e tubular, trichord etc).
 - Over road (type?) or over other?
 - Size height, width,
 - Full over road vs partial (Gantry, Cantilever, Monopod + or other suitable term/structure)
 - Date of build/Installation
 - Cost of structure
 - Cost of installation
 - Cost of structure replacement
 - Design life Spec (i.e 10, 25, 50 years) Expected rebuild/replacement date
 - Who built the structure
 - Who installed the structure
 - Any future planned structures in the next 5 years
 - Maintenance company

We have reviewed our Road Maintenance database and can confirm the Kāpiti Coast District Council have no over-road structures within our roading network. On that basis
