1. Can I please ask about the Potholes that have been fixed on Park Avenue 5 times before the final proper fix that cleared up all the broken roading and surrounding area with hot mix. - This is \_\_\_\_\_\_ on the street side.


The Pavement has been failing in this spot. Potholing was completed each time the road opened until we completed the larger repair. We had to eliminate if it was a Water/sewer/stormwater/utility failure first.

I note for the last year or more there has been white markings around the pothole to indicate work is to come and fix a slightly larger area than just the impacted pothole. This makes sense when looking at it.

2. I note it was spot repaired 5 times (after wet weather in each instance) prior to the final fix and my question is, can you outline the cost of the 5 spot fixes and then the cost of the final fix please? This is throughout the calendar year for 2024.
