Thank you for your email of **29 April 2024** requesting the following information:

I am forwarding you my request for information that was sent ██████████ on 29 April... ██████████ was meant to contact Coastal Adaptation Panel member, Susie Mills, regarding her comments in a meeting of 20 March, 2024, in which she stated that she was aware of an insurance company that will no longer insure in Kapiti. I was requesting the name of the insurance company that Miss Mills was referring to.

Susie Mills confirmed that the basis of her comment referred to a [Radio New Zealand interview](#) with Squirrel Chief Executive David Cunningham. At minute 20 of the recording there is a discussion around “risk-based pricing” and a Kapiti example is noted where one insurance company said they would not ensure the property in question.
