Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your email of **30 October 2024** requesting the following information:

- 1. All information regarding the dune restoration at Paraparaumu Beach.***
- 2. The flyer that was sent out to the beachfront residents re dune restoration.***

On 19 November 2024, you refined your request of Question 1 to:

...copies of all correspondence exchanged between property owners at [REDACTED] Manly street and KCDC council staff and elected members, related to the Paraparaumu Beach Dune Restoration Project that refers to species to be planted and actions that will be taken.

Please find e-mails attached of correspondence which documents who authorised the July planting and who ordered or chose the plants that were planted then.

Please note that some information has been withheld under section 7(2)(a) of the LGOIMA 1987 to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons

Regarding Question 2, please find attached a copy of flyers that have been sent to the beachfront residents regarding dune restoration over the past 18 months.

In Council's view the reasons for withholding these details are not outweighed by public interest considerations in section 7(1) favouring their release.
